

The Global Wealth Pyramid



Number of adults (% of world adults)

Life is a big pyramid scheme

- The bottom 55% of the world population controls only 1.3% of the wealth in the world
- The bottom 88% of the world controls 15% of the resources in the world
- The top 12% controls 85% of the resources
- The top 1% controls 45%

It's not just life, every industry is also designed like a pyramid



The ones just getting pulled along




Riders

The ones who slow the whole organization down


You can be a high-achieving visionary driver, but if you gather a team of walkers and riders, all your lofty ideas are dead on arrival

- Know when to cut the rope








